A research project 	We would like you to spend some time researching one of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - An astronaut - An astronomer - A space mission - A planet Once you have completed the research decide how you would like to present your findings. You could create a PowerPoint presentation, speech, a quiz, poster or a fact file. Try to be as creative as possible and remember we expect to see factual information incorporated. You are welcome to include a piece of artwork or a model to accompany your research project.
Maths 	Times tables - Studyzone Every week you are expected to complete 20mins of times tables practice on Studyzone. The more practice you do, the better you will be able to use your times tables to help you with your Maths work. The homework activities will be set for you each week, but you can always do more to increase your speed. Families without internet access at home should speak directly to the class teacher; time can be set aside to allow children to utilise the school iPads for Studyzone. Weekly tests may be given in classes.
Grammar 	GPS A grammar or punctuation task will be sent home every Friday and should be completed by the following Tuesday and returned to school for marking.
Reading 	Accelerated Reading (AR) All children are expected to read an AR book within their AR Range for 15 minutes, three times a week . Of course, any additional time spent reading is always a bonus! After reading the book, your child will take a short quiz on an ipad in school. The quiz scores are recorded in your child's Learning Log along with their increasing AR Range.
Spelling 	Set start of term Weekly tests Every Friday, the children will be tested on their weekly spellings. copy their spellings into their learning journal with a specific focus. Termly spelling cards have been uploaded to the website, however these are subject to change at the teacher's discretion to best suit the needs of the class. You will be practising them at school, but it is really important that you practise at home too. Ask an adult to help you. You should highlight each word once you can <u>definitely</u> spell it!
